

**WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP
RESOLUTION 08-10**

A RESOLUTION TO WORK WITH THE MUNICIPALITIES OF CALN TOWNSHIP, EAST BRANDYWINE TOWNSHIP AND WEST BRANDYWINE TOWNSHIP TO ACQUIRE A HORIZONTAL GRINDER TO USE IN A PROGRAM FOR MANAGING YARD WASTES AND OTHER WOOD RESIDUE THAT CAN BE GROUND INTO A USABLE PRODUCT

WHEREAS, West Bradford Township desires to limit the amount of yard waste material and other tree and wood residue that is disposed of in the landfill, and;

WHEREAS, the Township proposes to create a facility for drop-off of yard waste, tree limbs, small stumps, non-treated wood building materials, wood pallets and other similar wood waste as a service to the citizens, and;

WHEREAS, that system will remove costs for placing these items in the landfill and will create a usable mulch product, and;

WHEREAS, it is not feasible for the Township to own and operate a horizontal grinder without provision for other use, and;


WHEREAS, it is feasible for several municipalities to share use and ownership of a horizontal grinder for maximum value to be gained from use of such a machine, and;

WHEREAS, the municipalities named herein have worked together successfully in the past and have knowledge that they can manage the sharing of this machine to the benefit of each municipality.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT, and it hereby is resolved that West Bradford Township join with Caln Township, East Brandywine Township and West Brandywine Township to place an application with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to acquire a horizontal grinder to be owned and used by the participating municipalities.


