**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 2008-05 EMERGENCY SERVICES
BOARD BY ADDING ADDITIONAL MEMBERS TO THE BOARD AND
ADJUSTING THE TERMS OF OFFICE**

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to have additional community representation on the Emergency Services Board, and;

WHEREAS, the ESB now has one community representative and it is desirous to have a total of three community at large representatives in addition to Township representatives and Fire Company representatives.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT and it is hereby resolved that; The Emergency Services Board shall include three members of the community at large appointed by the Board of Supervisors.


The term of office for each appointee shall be four years. Initially, one community member shall be appointed for a term of two years, one shall be appointed for three years and one shall be appointed for four years.


