

**WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE 2010-01**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 06-05, "THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE;" ORDINANCE 07-01 "THE INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE 2006 EDITION;" ORDINANCE 78-01 "WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE EVENT OF SNOW EMERGENCIES;" ORDINANCE 85-01, "REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP;" AND ORDINANCE 99-03 (AMENDING ORDINANCES 77-03 AND 96-03) "WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP REFUSE CONTROL AND BURNING ORDINANCE"

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Bradford, Chester County, Pennsylvania, that amendments shall be as follows:

SECTION 1.

Ordinance 06-05, Add to Section 3.

Section 503.4 "Violation and Penalty for Obstruction of Fire Apparatus Access Road."

A notice of violation may be issued followed by a citation or a citation may be issued without being preceded by a notice of violation.

- A. Any action by any person, firm, corporation or other entity which violates or does not comply with this Ordinance shall be punishable by fine(s) as established in this section. Each day that a violation occurs shall be considered a separate violation.
- B. Any owner or occupant of a dwelling unit, any person, firm, corporation or other entity in violation of any portion(s) of this Ordinance shall be issued a notice of violation and be ordered to pay a fine of \$20, payable to the Township of West Bradford within 14 days of issuance of such a notice.
- C. Failure to respond to the notice of violation set forth in subsection B above by payment of the fine aforesaid, which payment must be made to the Township of West Bradford within 14 days of issuance of such notice, shall result in the issuance of a citation to the defendant. Thereafter, the prosecution shall proceed in accordance with the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure and upon conviction for the offense, the defendant shall be ordered to pay the fine hereinabove set forth, or in the case of subsequent violations, as set forth in subsection D, below, together with the costs of prosecution and/or to be incarcerated in the County Prison for not more than five days.
- D. The fine for the first violation of this Ordinance shall be twenty dollars (\$20); for any subsequent conviction the fine shall be not less than fifty dollars (\$50) and may be punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) and/or be incarcerated in the County Prison for not more than five days.

Ordinance 78-01, Section 13; Ordinance 85-01, Section XI and Ordinance 99-03, Section 8 - Replace These Sections with the following:

"Violation and Penalty." A notice of violation may be issued followed by a citation or a citation may be issued without being preceded by a notice of violation.

- A. Any action by any person, firm, corporation or other entity which violates or does not comply with any provision of this Ordinance or any regulation thereof shall be punishable by fine(s) as established in this section. Each day that a violation occurs shall be considered a separate violation.
- B. Any owner or occupant of a dwelling unit, any person, firm, corporation or other entity in violation of any portion(s) of this Ordinance shall be issued a notice of violation and be ordered to pay a fine of \$20, payable to the Township of West Bradford within 14 days of issuance of such a notice.
- E. Failure to respond to the notice of violation set forth in subsection B above by payment of the fine aforesaid, which payment must be made to the Township of West Bradford within 14 days of issuance of such notice, shall result in the issuance of a citation to the defendant. Thereafter, the prosecution shall proceed in accordance with the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure and upon conviction for the offense, the defendant shall be ordered to pay the fine hereinabove set forth, or in the case of subsequent violations, as set forth in subsection D, below, together with the costs of prosecution and/or to be incarcerated in the County Prison for not more than five days.
- F. The fine for the first violation of this Ordinance shall be twenty dollars (\$20); for any subsequent conviction the fine shall be not less than fifty dollars (\$50) and may be punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) and/or be incarcerated in the County Prison for not more than five days.

SECTION 2 – Severability Clause

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


SECTION 3 – Effective Date
