

**TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD
RESOLUTION 10-04**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE REVISED
CHESTER COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Chester County Board of Commissioners has compiled a revision adopted December 2, 2009 to the Chester County Municipal Solid Waste Plan originally adopted in 1990 and revised in March, 2007 in accordance with the provisions of Act 101 – "The Pennsylvania Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act" of July 28, 1988;

WHEREAS, the 2009 revision ensures that disposal capacity is available for waste generated within Chester County for the ten year planning period 2010 to 2019;

WHEREAS, the revision continues to include Lanchester and SECCRA Landfills as the Primary Disposal Facilities for Chester County generated wastes, adds an additional seven By-Pass Disposal facilities to the twelve By-Pass Disposal sites already named in the March, 2007 revision and includes a Designated Site Ordinance which replaces the County's existing Flow Control Ordinance;


WHEREAS, this revision does not include any changes to the County's recycling program or goals;

WHEREAS, the appropriate officials of West Bradford Township have reviewed the 2009 Plan revisions, have found the revisions acceptable and recommend that the revised 2009 Plan be adopted;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township hereby accepts and adopts the 2009 Revision to the Solid Waste Management Plan prepared and adopted by Chester County in accordance with the provisions of Act 101.




