

**TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD
RESOLUTION 10-12**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING LOCATION OF A SUITABLE
POLLING PLACE FOR THE FIFTH PRECINCT WITHIN A
REASONABLE DISTANCE OUTSIDE THE PRECINCT BOUNDARIES**

WHEREAS, a suitable polling place cannot be found within the boundary of the fifth precinct of West Bradford Township; and,

WHEREAS, the present polling place is being used as a temporary measure and has caused complaint from many voters as to its suitability; and,

WHEREAS, polling places are not typically located outside of the boundary of a precinct unless they are in a government building; and,

WHEREAS, there are not any government buildings located within a reasonable distance from the boundary of the fifth precinct; and,


WHEREAS, there are suitable buildings owned by other organizations that may be used within a reasonable distance from the boundary of the fifth precinct; and,

WHEREAS, a diligent search has been made within the fifth precinct for a suitable facility for a polling place and none has been found.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township that by permission of proper authorities, the Bureau of Voter Services be allowed to establish a suitable polling place outside of but within a reasonable distance from the boundary of the fifth precinct so that the voters of that district may properly exercise their voting privilege in a suitable facility or as an alternative, change the district boundary so that the district is inclusive of facilities that may be a suitable polling place.




