RESOLUTION 10-22**

***A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP HISTORIC
RESOURCE ATLAS AS PREPARED BY CHESTER COUNTY AND CLARIFYING THE
CATEGORIZATION OF HISTORIC RESOURCES IN WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP***

WHEREAS, the West Bradford Township Historical Commission has consulted with Chester County in the preparation of the “West Bradford Township Historic Resource Atlas”, completed in November 2010; and

WHEREAS, West Bradford Township wishes to recognize this achievement and also establish the controlling documentation for the official listing of historical resources in West Bradford Township; and

WHEREAS, the “West Bradford Township Historic Resource Atlas” includes resources that utilize the selection criteria established in the Chester County Historic Sites Survey, namely all historic resources (structures) identified as being fifty (50) years or older; and

WHEREAS, West Bradford Township is very fortunate to have many significant historical resources that date from the 18th, 19th, and early 20th Centuries and the inclusion of all structures greater than 50 years old, regardless of their contextual significance, would diminish the importance of, and make the task of protecting the significant resources more difficult;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that

1. WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY hereby recognizes the “West Bradford Township Historic Resource Atlas” as a useful resource tool to our residents and Historical Commission; and
2. That the official listing of Township recognized historical resources shall continue to be the West Bradford Township Comprehensive Plan and the criteria for the identification of Township as outlined in Resolution 2005-22, namely


The following characteristics shall be utilized to determine the initial historical significance of buildings, structures, sites, objects, and landmarks in West Bradford Township. Further research and documentation may be completed to justify the actual preservation of these.

1. An age of seventy-five (75) years or older containing features of general historical, architectural, cultural, archaeological merit, or
2. An age of fifty years (50) years or older containing particular historical, architectural, cultural, archaeological merit significant in that:
 - i. It can be identified with a historical personage or event;
 - ii. It is representative of a period style of architecture;

- iii. It is a notable work of a recognized master architect, designer, or builder who influenced his/her era; or
- 3. It has particular significance for any reasons of local, state, or national history.


