RESOLUTION 11-23

**A RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION FOR AN
ACT 537 OFFICIAL SEWAGE FACILITIES PLAN**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537 known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection ("the Department") adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, required municipalities to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage facilities adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the URS Corporation has prepared an Official Sewage Facilities Plan ("the Plan") which provides for sewage facilities in the entirety of West Bradford Township; and

WHEREAS, the selected alternatives indicated in the Plan are: 1) new development in the Utilities Incorporated of Pennsylvania Study Area will be served by individual on-lot sewage systems unless sufficient capacity is available within the existing permitted Broad Run wastewater treatment plant capacity; 2) new development in the DuPont Wastewater Treatment Facility Study Area will be served by the DuPont Wastewater Treatment Facility or individual on-lot sewage systems as permitted by applicable zoning ordinance standards; 3) the equivalent dwelling unit value for DuPont Wastewater Treatment Facility service will be revised from 250 to 225 gallons per day; 4) The Romansville Study Area will continue to be served by on-lot sewage systems, excepting phase 1 of the Stargazers development which will be served by the DuPont Wastewater Facility; 5) no action is warranted at this time for the Strasburg Corridor Study Area; 6) no action is warranted at this time for the Embreeville Center Study Area; 7) the Appleville Mobile Home Park Study Area will continue to be served by on-lot community sewage systems; 8) The Residential Study Area will continue to be served by on-lot sewage systems; and 9) All portions of the Township that will continue to be served by individual or community on-lot sewage systems will be subject to an on-lot sewage management program; and


WHEREAS, West Bradford Township desires to modify the aforementioned selected alternatives to exclude revision to the DuPont Wastewater Facility equivalent dwelling unit value, thereby maintaining the current value of 250 gallons per day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that West Bradford Township has found the Plan, as modified above, adequate for the wastewater disposal and management needs of the municipality and hereby adopts the Plan known as the West Bradford Township Official Sewage Facilities Plan, dated March 2011 and revised August 2011 as a revision to the Official Plan of the municipality. The West Bradford Township Board of Supervisors hereby assures the Department of the proper and timely implementation of said Plan as set forth herein.


