

## Township Offers Cardboard Drop-off

West Bradford Township will now be allowing residents to drop-off corrugated cardboard materials for recycling at the Township Campus. This is to provide residents with a convenient outlet for their cardboard and to fill the void left by the closing of the Accurate Recycling facility in Downingtown.

The only materials accepted at the Township Campus drop-off facility are corrugated cardboard, green glass and brown glass. All cardboard must be flattened and placed through the slot in the fence. Please push the cardboard completely through the opening to avoid jamming it for other residents. Green and brown glass must be placed in the appropriate receptacles located along the fence.

All other recyclable materials that are currently part of the Township's overall refuse and recycling program (newsprint – including magazines, junk mail & cereal boxes; plastics #1 - #7; clear, green & brown glass bottles and jars; aluminum, bimetal & steel beverage and food cans) will continue to be collected curbside.

Depositing of trash and other materials not currently accepted at the Campus drop-off facility is strictly prohibited. We do our best to keep this facility as neat and clean as possible and ask for your assistance in this endeavor. Please realize that the drop-off area is monitored and anyone caught dumping trash or other material is subject to fine.
