**THE HISTORICAL COMMISSION** consists of seven members. The members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and serve a term of three years. The members serve without compensation.

The Commission has been established to record the history of West Bradford Township, gather information on the historical resources that may be affected during development and provide recommendations to the Township Planning Commission on mitigating these impacts. They oversee update of the historical components of the Township's Comprehensive Plan at a minimum of every ten years.

The Commission also will develop a public education and outreach program on the Township's history and its important sites, advise and assist the Board of Supervisors and Township staff in the acquisition or restoration of any objects and sites relative to the Township's history, seek grant funding for activities and projects approved by the Board of Supervisors and gather documentary evidence, illustrations, photographs and other appropriate materials that will establish architecture and landmarks as significant and worthy of protection.
