**ORDINANCE 2004-07**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED  
LIMIT ON A SECTION OF T-425**

**BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP**, in accordance with Act 151 of 1998, it is determined that Gallagherville Road is not a numbered traffic route and is functionally classified as a local highway, and is in a residential district and therefore the following maximum speed limit is established on the specified street, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that street.

**MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT**




Any person who violates the provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation of the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania and subject to the penalties therein provided.




