RESOLUTION 04-03**

Procedures for the Disposition of Surplus Property under \$1,000

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township are permitted under the Second Class Township Code to purchase and dispose of property that they judge to be in the best interests of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the costs to sell or dispose of personal property under one-thousand (\$1,000) dollars by formal bid have been found to be excessive; and

WHEREAS, the net proceeds from alternate sale methods would provide greater revenue to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code (Section 1504) allows alternate methods to be established for the sale or disposition of property upon formal procedures being established by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that surplus personal property owned by West Bradford Township, of an estimated fair market value of less than one-thousand (\$1,000) dollars, shall be auctioned off electronically by a service such as eBay, or other similar service;

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Township Manager or Assistant Township Manager shall from time to time determine property to be declared surplus and shall direct that that property be disposed of in accordance with the above-mentioned procedure;

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the language in this resolution shall not be construed to prohibit:

- *The exchange of personal property for new personal property; and/or*
- *The sale, lease, or donation of personal property to any municipal corporation or authority, Federal or State agency, or non-profit organization.*
