**DEDICATION OF AN ADDITION TO THE BRANDYWINE MEADOWS PRESERVE**

*WHEREAS, West Bradford Township has purchased and acquired, in lieu of condemnation, from Sonoco Products Company that certain tract or parcel of land situate in West Bradford Township generally bounded by Route 322 on the west, the Township's Brandywine Meadows Preserve on the north, and the East Branch of the Brandywine Creek on the east, and;*

*FURTHER, the property boundaries are described as being tax parcel #50-3-6 containing 17.78 acres, more or less, and being more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and based upon a survey plan dated June 4, 2004 by Lake Roeder Hillard & Associates, Land Surveyors, and;*

*WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Supervisors that the acquisition of said open space, as protected habitat and floodplain, for non-motorized trail use, and for limited passive recreation is in the best interests of West Bradford Township.*

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township hereby dedicate this parcel as an addition to the Brandywine Meadows Preserve.*
