**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD
ZONING ORDINANCE BY DELETING THE PRESENT ARTICLE 700 FLOOD
HAZARD DISTRICT AND REPLACING THE SAID ARTICLE WITH A NEW
ARTICLE 700 FLOOD HAZARD DISTRICT**

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Bradford, Chester County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1 – Delete Article 700 Flood Hazard District.


SECTION 2 – Add a new Article 700 Flood Hazard District as attached hereto as exhibit “A”.

SECTION 3 – If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.




