A RESOLUTION EXTOLLING THE DEDICATION OF SERGEANT DOUGLAS O'CONNOR, PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE, TO MAKE THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS SAFER BY UTILIZING SAFETY STOPS, DUI CHECKPOINTS AND ENCOURAGING PROPER USE OF ALL ENFORCEMENT POWERS OF THE OFFICERS IN HIS COMMAND

WHEREAS, Sergeant Douglas O'Connor is a member of the Pennsylvania State Police, and;

WHEREAS, Sergeant O'Connor is stationed with Troop J, Embreeville Barracks, and is the Patrol Sergeant for that barracks, and;

WHEREAS, he has taken every opportunity to make our roads safer though his position with the Pennsylvania State Police, and;

WHEREAS, he has operated numerous traffic safety checkpoints to assure compliance with regulations regarding use of the public highways, and;

WHEREAS, he has operated a number of Driving Under the Influence Checkpoints to remove impaired drivers from the roadway, and;

WHEREAS, he has encouraged those under his command to be vigilant when dealing with traffic safety issues and with those that violate the laws which have been established to promote the safe use of our highways, and;

WHEREAS, the Troopers of Embreeville Barracks have issued 390 DUI citations during the year, of which 73% were on view arrests which occurred prior to being involved in accidents, and;

WHEREAS, the removal of drivers who are DUI prior to them being involved in a traffic accident has in all probability saved many from injury and loss of life, and;


WHEREAS, the number of charges for DUI when compared to other efforts in this regard across the Commonwealth are superior in number, and;

WHEREAS, the accomplishments regarding safety on the highways by Sergeant O'Connor are noteworthy.




