UNACCEPTABLE RECYCLING ITEMS

The Following Cannot Be Recycled:

- Plastic lids.
- Plastic bags your local grocery store will accept plastic bags
- Pet food bags (even if they are marked #5)
- Garbage, food waste, food tainted items (used paper plates, paper towels or napkins)
- Polystyrene cups or plates
- Motor oil bottles



- Styrofoam (even if marked 1-7)
- Hazardous chemical containers (flammable liquids)
- Latex Paint cans latex paint cans can be placed in refuse toter after all paint has dried up (kitty litter or sawdust stirred in will help to dry up liquid).
- Oil based paint cans must be turned in to hazardous waste drop-off sites.
- Foam egg cartons
- Milk or ice cream cartons
- Light bulbs
- Plastic toys or sporting goods
- Electronics or batteries



- Scrap metal i.e., vehicle parts, bolts, nuts screws (take to local scrap yard)
- Used tissues, diapers and paper towels



- Hangers
- Yard waste or garden tools
- Hard cover books (unless you take the cover off and put it in refuse toter)
