

ORDINANCE # 71-9

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCARDING OF REFRIGERATORS AND ICE BOXES WITHOUT THE REMOVAL OF SELF-LOCKING OR SELF-LATCHING DOORS THEREFROM AND PROVIDING FOR IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Section 1. No ice box, refrigerator or other locked or self-locking container shall be discarded within the Township of West Bradford unless the doors and hinges shall be first removed or permanently closed and secured.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance upon conviction in any summary proceeding shall be sentenced to pay a fine to the use of the Township of not more than \$300.00 and cost of prosecution, or, upon default of payment of the fine and costs, to be sentenced and committed to the county jail for a period of not more than 30 days. Whenever any such person shall be notified by certified mail or personal services by the Township or any official thereof that such violation to this Ordinance exists, each day that such violation shall continue after notification, shall constitute a separate offense, punishable by like fine or imprisonment.

Section 3. All prior Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective five days after enactment.

Section 5. Should any Section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any other part thereof.
