

ORDINANCE 1975 - 3

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING HALL ROAD AS A THROUGH STREET AT BOTH INTERSECTIONS OF SHERWOOD DRIVE AND DIRECTING THE ERECTION OF APPROPRIATE TRAFFIC CONTROLS WITH RESPECT THERETO.

BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS, by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township, ENACTED AND ORDAINED:

1. Hall Road from Route 322 to a point west of the westerly intersection of Sherwood Drive is, except as may hereafter be ordained, declared to be a through street.

2. Sherwood Drive, at both of its intersections with Hall Road, is declared to be a stop street.

3. The proper officers of the Township are directed to procure and cause to be erected appropriate, lawful traffic control stop signs in accordance with Pennsylvania Department of Transportation regulations and to erect the same on the easterly side of both intersections of Sherwood Drive, on the south side of Hall Road, facing in a southerly direction.

4. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance and the traffic controls hereby established shall be guilty of a violation of the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania and subject to the penalties therein provided.

5. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment or on the date the traffic control signs are installed, whichever be the later date.
