Ordinance No. 78-5 of 1978

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD, CHESTER COUNTY COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO JOIN THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER ARTICLE IV OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW; AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL PROVISIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW, AS AMENDED AND AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES JOINING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE; STATING WHICH OF CERTAIN OPTIONS PERMITTED UNDER THE SAID LAW ARE ACCEPTED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD.

Be it ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board Of Supervisors of the Township of West Bradford, Chester County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section I. The Township of West Bradford hereby elects to join the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, established by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, Act 15, 1974, as amended, and does hereby agree to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of the said Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law and the amendments thereto and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise, placed upon member municipalities by said Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law and the amendments thereto.

Section II. Membership in the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System for elected officials shall be optional and membership therein for employes hired on a temporary or seasonal basis shall be prohibited. The election by elected

officials and employes hired on a temporary or seasonal basis to join said System must be made within one year from the date of this Ordinance Resolution, or within one year after the officials or employes first enter the service of the Township of West Bradford.

Officers and employes paid wholly on a fee basis shall not be eligible for membership in the System.

Section III. Credit for prior service toward the municipal annuity of each original member shall be for all years of service to the Township of West Bradford.

The Township of West Bradford does hereby assume the liability for payment of 100 percentum (100%) of the original member's contributions for all years of service of each original member.

Section IV. Payment for the prior service as set forth in Section III hereof shall be made by the Township of West Bradford in accordance with said Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law.

Section V. The Township of West Bradford does hereby elect to extend the provisions of Section 209 of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, Act 15 of 1974, so that contributions to the Retirement System shall have the options and enjoy the protections set forth in subsections (b) and (c) of Section 209 of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, Section 209 is hereby incorporated and made a part hereof by reference hereto.

Section VI. As part of this Ordinance the Township of West Bradford agrees to the outline of benefits set forth in the cost study letter of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board,

dated December 6, 1978. The passage and adoption of this Ordinance by the Township of West Bradford is an official acceptance of said benefits.

Section VII. A duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and membership for the Township of West Bradford in the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System shall be effective the first day of January, 1979.
