

Ordinance 81-07

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING A SPEED
LIMIT FOR STOUFF ROAD (T-408) and
BANNING TRUCK TRAFFIC FROM THAT
SAME ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED and it is hereby ordained by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township, in accordance with a recommendation, after review, by the Township Engineer, that Stouff Road (T-408) between West Chester Road and the Caln Township line shall be established as a twenty-five (25) mile per hour speed zone. The Township Manager is instructed to erect the necessary signs to comply with the provisions of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Further, Stouff Road between West Chester Road and the Caln Township line, shall be deemed unsafe for truck traffic in accordance with a recommendation, after review, by the Township Engineer. Truck traffic shall not be permitted to use Stouff Road except for necessary service to properties abutting thereon, so much as that service is for a lawful use as decreed by the West Bradford Township Zoning Ordinance. The Township Manager is instructed to erect the necessary signs to comply with the provisions of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
