

Ordinance 84-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD AMENDING ORDINANCE #12, ADOPTED FEBRUARY 14, 1967, AND ORDINANCE #18, ADOPTED JANUARY 13, 1969, REGULATING JUNK YARDS AND SCRAP YARDS WITHIN WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP.

SECTION I. The section of Ordinance #12, known as Section II., and being Section I. of Ordinance #18, is amended so as to read as follows: "SECTION II. No person shall be a junk dealer or own, lease, operate or maintain a junk yard as herein defined within the township without first obtaining a license to operate a junk yard as a junk dealer. The annual fee for such a license shall be prescribed by a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors; the license shall be effective for one calendar year only, each license terminating on December 31, of the year for which it is issued subject to renewal upon reapplication. Application for a license or any renewal thereof shall be filed in writing with the secretary of the Board, and shall contain the applicant's sworn statement setting forth the applicant's name and address, together with the names and addresses of all other persons interested in the business, an accurate description of the premises upon which the business is located, including the Chester County tax parcel number and a statement that applicant will comply with the ordinance and any regulations adopted pursuant to the ordinance. Upon receipt of the application and license fee as set by resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the township, by the township, if the application complies with the provisions hereof, the secretary of the Board, shall within ten (10) days issue its license authorizing the operation and maintenance of a junk yard upon the premises by the junk dealer. Such license shall at all times be conspicuously displayed upon the junk yard premises. The license shall be non-transferrable both as to the junk yard premises and junk dealer."

SECTION II. Section roman numeral II. of Ordinance #12, and Ordinance #18 shall be deleted, and Section I. of this ordinance

shall become the Section II. of those ordinances.

SECTION III. All other sections of those ordinances shall remain the same as previously adopted.
