

Ordinance 85-01

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC  
STREETS WITHIN WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Bradford, County of Chester, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, this 26th day of March, 1985.

SECTION I. The public streets within West Bradford Township shall not be used as a place to repair vehicles. However, necessary emergency repairs may be made in order to remove vehicles that have broken down.

SECTION II. The public streets within West Bradford Township shall not be used to store motor vehicles without current license and/or inspection being displayed on the vehicle.

SECTION III. The public streets within West Bradford Township shall not be used to store any trailer, boat, motor home, other vehicle, or recreational vehicle designed to be towed, transported, or otherwise whether or not it is subject to license or inspection.

SECTION IV No motor vehicle shall be stored or parked on an operating lane for a period of more than 72 hours.

SECTION V Burning of leaves or other debris on the paved surface or concrete gutter is prohibited.

SECTION VI Storage of any material on the public right-of-way is prohibited.

SECTION VII Raking of leaves or debris into the street or gutter system is prohibited.

SECTION VIII Driving of track vehicles on paved streets or concrete gutter is prohibited, except when approved by the Board of Supervisors or their agents as necessary for snow removal or other emergencies.

SECTION IX The placement of signs within the dedicated right-of-ways in West Bradford Township shall be prohibited unless a proper permit has been issued. In addition to any other remedy at law these signs, placed without permit, may be removed by the Board of Supervisors or their agents.

SECTION X Planting of shrubs, trees, or other plantings other than grass and groundcover is prohibited on dedicated right-of-ways.

SECTION XI Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance in a summary proceeding before any District Justice

shall pay a fine not in excess of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of the fine and costs, shall be sentenced to imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION XII Severability - If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
