

ORDINANCE 87-06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
A STOP STREET ON
CREAGH KNOLL LANE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP as follows:

SECTION I. The following named Township Street shall be a stop street.

1. Creagh Knoll Lane (T-492), southbound lane, at its intersection with New Hampshire Lane (T-494).

SECTION II. The proper officers of the Township are directed to procure and cause to be erected appropriate, lawful traffic control stop signs in accordance with Pennsylvania Department of Transportation regulations and to erect the same on the southbound lane of Creagh Knoll Lane at its intersection with New Hampshire Lane and place a placard on this sign and the stop sign on New Hampshire Lane indicating a three way stop.

SECTION III. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance and the traffic controls hereby established shall be guilty of a violation of the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania and subject to the penalties therein provided.
