

ORDINANCE 88-02

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING  
A SPEED LIMIT ON CERTAIN  
CUL-DE-SAC STREETS OWNED  
BY WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP in accordance with a recommendation from the Township Engineer, that all cul-de-sac streets owned by West Bradford Township that are at least 540 feet in length shall be established as a twenty-five (25) mile per hour speed zone.

For purposes of this Ordinance a cul-de-sac road is considered to be any road with a singular entrance culminating in a turn around whether it be temporarily or permanently designed as such.

The length of the cul-de-sac shall be measured from a point at the intersection of the cul-de-sac road with the edge of the street to which it connects to the farther paved end of the cul-de-sac circle or turn around.

This Ordinance shall not apply to any street that has been separately designated for a speed limit by other Ordinances.

The Township Manager is instructed to erect the necessary signs to comply with the provisions of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance and the traffic controls hereby established shall be guilty of a violation of the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania and subject to the penalties therein provided.
