

TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD  
ORDINANCE 92-04

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING  
A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON  
LIEDS ROAD  
BETWEEN BROAD RUN ROAD AND STRASBURG ROAD


Be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township, in accordance with a recommendation from the township engineer, that the following maximum speed limit is established on the portion of the specified street, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>	<u>MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS</u>
Lieds Rd. - (T-376)	Broad Run Road to Strasburg Road	25 m.p.h.

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation of the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania and subject to the penalties therein provided.
