

**TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD
ORDINANCE #95-01**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON
CRESTMONT DRIVE, WOODWARD DRIVE AND ON WALTON DRIVE.**


Be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township, in accordance with a recommendation from the township engineer, that the following maximum speed limit is established on the portion of the specified street, as follows and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>	<u>MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT</u>
Crestmont Dr. (T-436)	Marshallton-Thorndale Rd. to Shadyside Road	25 m.p.h.
Woodward Drive (T-435B)	Crestmont Drive to Shadyside Rd.	25 m.p.h.
Walton Drive (T-444)		25 m.p.h.

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation of the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania and subject to the penalties therein provided.


