

**TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD
ORDINANCE #95-10**

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING A PORTION OF
STRASBURG ROAD IN THE VILLAGE OF ROMANSVILLE
AN URBAN DISTRICT AND ESTABLISHING A 35 MPH
SPEED LIMIT.**

Whereas, Chapter 211 of Title 67 of the Pennsylvania Code permits a municipality to create a 35 miles per hour speed limit in an Urban District.

It is hereby ordained, by the Board of Supervisors, that:

Section 1 - The area of S.R. 3062 (Strasburg Road) within the Village of Romansville, specifically from segment/offset 180/2186 to segment/offset 200/0000 qualifies as an Urban District and is hereby designated an Urban District.


Section 2 - The Urban District area on S.R. 3062 (Strasburg Road) shall have a speed limit of 35 miles per hour, as permitted by Title 67, Chapter 211.71(e)(i) of the Pennsylvania Code.

Section 3 - With the approval of the Department of Transportation, the appropriate signs shall be placed.

Section 4 - This ordinance shall take effect immediately or upon placement of the appropriate signs, whichever be the later date.
