ORDINANCE #95-11**


**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A STOP STREET ON
ROMIG ROAD (T-526) AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH
HAMPTON DRIVE AND PENNSFORD DRIVE,
WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP.**

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP, as per study done by Caruolo Associates, Inc., Transportation Engineers/Planners, as follows:

- SECTION I.** The following named township streets shall be stop streets.
Romig Road, (T-526) at its intersection with Hampton Drive and Pennsford Drive, eastbound lane and westbound lane.
- SECTION II.** The proper officers of the township are directed to procure and cause to be erected, appropriate, lawful, traffic control stop signs in accordance with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's regulations and to erect the same on the eastbound and westbound lanes of traffic on Romig Road at its intersection with Hampton Drive and Pennsford Drive.
- SECTION III.** Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance and the traffic controls hereby established shall be guilty of a violation of the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania and subject to the penalties therein provided.
