ORDINANCE NO . 97-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD,
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO RESTORE THE ABILITY
OF WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP TO ENFORCE CERTAIN
ORDINANCES BY CRIMINAL PROCEDURE WITH A MAXIMUM
FINE FOR VIOLATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000.00 AND TO
PROVIDE THAT ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP
WILL BE ENFORCED BY CIVIL PROCEDURE WITH A MAXIMUM
FINE OF \$600.00 PER VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Township of
West Bradford as follows:

Section 1. All Ordinances of West Bradford Township regulating building, housing, property maintenance, health, fire, public safety, parking, solicitation, curfew, water, air or noise pollution are hereby amended so as to provide that they shall be enforced as a summary offense under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure pursuant to the mandate of Act 172 of 1996; said Ordinances further being amended to provide a maximum fine for each violation not to exceed \$1,000.00.


Section 2. All other Township Ordinances shall be enforced by a civil procedure with a maximum fine of \$600.00 per violation pursuant to the mandate of Act 172 of 1996.

Section 3. All Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.




