ORDINANCE 97-04

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING INTERGOVERNMENTAL
COOPERATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF SHARING OF FACILITIES,
CREATING SHARED USE OF PARKING AND ROADWAYS AND USES
OF SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPERTY FOR RECREATION FACILITIES.**

The Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township hereby ordains:

SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Downingtown Area School District to accomplish the following:

- A. To construct and use a shared roadway to West Bradford Elementary School and Broad Run Park on property of either the school district or West Bradford Township.
- B. To construct and use shared parking facilities for the West Bradford Elementary School and Broad Run Park on property of either the school district or West Bradford Township.
- C. To allow the township to construct, use and maintain recreation facilities on property owned by the Downingtown Area School District at the West Bradford Elementary School.
- D. To cooperate in any manner as may be proper to accomplish the purposes of the school district and the township in serving the public through the sharing of facilities, property and equipment at the Broad Run Park and the West Bradford Elementary School; which properties are contiguous.


SECTION 2. The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors shall be authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to enter into an agreement with the DOWNTOWN AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT and any other pertinent documents consistent with the terms of this ordinance, following motion of the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 3. Any and all actions taken prior to the date of this ordinance by the Board of Supervisors, the township manager and other employees of the township in order to effectuate and enter into the agreement are hereby ratified.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective five days from enactment.




