

**TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE 02-07**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD
TO REPEAL CERTAIN OTHER ORDINANCES DEALING WITH
RESTRICTIONS OF TRUCK TRAFFIC ON VARIOUS ROADS

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1 – Purpose: To repeal truck traffic restrictions on certain roads in compliance with Act 33 of 2001.

Section 2 – The following Ordinances are repealed in their entirety:

Ordinance 81-07 Banning truck traffic on Stouff Road – T-408.

Ordinance 82-03 Banning truck traffic on Hall Road – T-387.

Ordinance 82-05 Banning truck traffic on Telegraph Road – T-381 (portion between Sugars Bridge and Marshallton-Thorndale Road).

Ordinance 82-08 Banning truck traffic on Broad Run Road – T-383 (portion between Route 162 and Strasburg Road).

Section 3 – Removing Signs

All signage, which was required by the Ordinances listed herein as being repealed, shall be removed.

Section 4 – Repealer

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 5 – Severability


If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 6 – Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.




