

DUMPING AND BURNING REGULATIONS

WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP II

AN ORDINANCE defining dumping and burning within the limits of West Bradford Township and providing penalties for the violation thereof:

BE IT ENACTED and ordained by the Supervisors of West Bradford Township and it is enacted and ordained by the authority of the same.

Section 1. No person or persons shall throw, dump or scatter any bottles, rags, paper, cans or any other refuse in any street, alley, lane or other place within the limits of West Bradford Township; provided, however, that any property owner may use his own property for the purpose of dumping domestic waste or his own refuse or may give consent to other property owners to dump on his premises at places not plainly visible from the public road or the property of adjoining owners.

Section 2. No person or persons shall dump, throw, scatter or otherwise dispose of any cans, bottles, paper or other refuse upon the property of any other owner within the limits of West Bradford Township, without the consent of the owner as provided in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3. No person or persons shall set fire to, burn or cause to be burned out of doors any papers, trash, leaves, grass or refuse after sunset, except with the permission of the Chief of the local fire department or, in his absence, of the person acting in that capacity; provided, however, that the burning of household trash in enclosed incinerators or other receptacles shall be exempted from the prohibition of this Section.

Section 4. Any person or persons who violate Section 3 of this ordinance shall upon conviction before any Justice of the Peace be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) together with costs and in default of payment thereof shall be committed to Chester County Prison for a period of not less than five (5) days nor more than fifteen (15) days. Any person or persons who violate Section 2 of this ordinance shall upon conviction before a Justice of the Peace be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) together with costs and in default of payment thereof shall be committed to Chester County Prison for not less than ten days (10) nor more than thirty (30) days.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts thereof in so far as the same may be inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
