

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT OR REGULATE THE
RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS AND PROVIDING
FOR A PENALTY THEREFOR

WEST BRADFORD TOWNSHIP XI

I. BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, at a regular monthly meeting held on the 9th day of August 1966, at 8:00 P.M. at the Marshallton Fire House:

1. It shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any dog to fail to keep at all times such dog either
 - (a) confined within an enclosure from which it cannot escape, or
 - (b) firmly secured by means of a collar and chain or other device so that it cannot stray beyond the premises on which it is secured, or
 - (c) under the reasonable control of some person or when engaged in lawful hunting accompanied by an owner or handler.

II. Any police officer may kill any dog found running at large within the township and unaccompanied and not under the control of the owner or handler.

III. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction by summary proceedings before a Justice of the Peace, be subject to a fine not exceeding \$300.00 plus costs of prosecution for each violation thereof and be subject to imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days in default of payment of such fine. A new and separate offense shall be deemed to have been committed for each day that said violation exists.
