ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX OF FIVE (\$5.00) DOLLARS,  
PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF COLLECTION AND PAYMENT  
THEREOF AND IMPOSING PENALTIES

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST BRADFORD  
TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, requires revenue to meet  
expenditures for general Township purposes, and it is estimated  
that a tax of Five (\$5.00) Dollars on each resident and taxpayer  
of said Township will produce annually approximately Nine Thousand  
One Hundred (\$9,100.00) Dollars and notice of intention to pass  
this ordinance having been given in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND  
ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the  
Local Tax Enabling Act of December 31, 1965, P.L. 1257, its supple-  
ments and amendments, there is hereby levied, assessed and imposed  
for general revenue purposes of West Bradford Township, Chester  
County, Pennsylvania, for the year 1970, a tax of Five (\$5.00)  
Dollars on each resident and taxpayer of said Township, twenty-one  
(21) years of age or over.

Section 2. Said tax shall be collected by the  
duly elected or appointed tax collector of township taxes for West  
Bradford Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, in the manner  
and at the same time or times as other township taxes are collected.

Section 3. The tax collector shall give bond  
for the faithful performance of his duties, secured and conditioned  
for the collection and payment of such taxes as provided by law for  
other township taxes.

Section 4. The expenses of collection and compensation of the tax collector shall be paid and allowed as provided by law, which compensation shall be the same as fixed from time to time by West Bradford Township for the collection of other township taxes.



Section 5. All taxpayers subject to the payment of the tax herein levied and assessed shall be entitled to the same discounts as allowed in the case of other similar township taxes.

Section 6. The tax levied and imposed under this ordinance shall be effective as of January 1, 1970, and this ordinance shall remain in effect during the calendar year of 1970 and so long thereafter as permitted under the Laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or until it may be amended, modified or repealed.

Section 7. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sections, clauses or sentences or parts of this ordinance.


