

RESOLUTION NO. 75 -

WHEREAS, Robert and Elizabeth Hodge have continued for a substantial period of time to maintain illegal mobile home pads on a portion of their lands in West Bradford Township, and

WHEREAS, demand has been made on numerous occasions for the removal thereof, but the Hodges fail and refuse to comply with said demands, and

WHEREAS, at a publicly held and duly advertised work session, the Board authorized the Township Solicitor to institute legal proceedings to cause the removal of the said illegal pads, but by omission, no formal minutes were taken reflecting the same, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the said instructions, the Solicitor did prepare a Complaint in Equity, which was duly attested by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors after review by all Supervisors and accordingly, the Complaint was thereupon duly filed and served, and

WHEREAS, the Board, at a subsequent regularly scheduled meeting, did approve reimbursement to the Solicitor for costs advanced for filing and service of the aforesaid Complaint, also in accordance with the original instructions.

NOW, THEREFORE, in order that the minutes of the Board of Supervisors may properly reflect all of the foregoing, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS, by the Board of Supervisors, RESOLVED that the Supervisors do hereby ratify all that has, to the date hereof,

been done in accordance with the above recited directions and further do hereby authorize and ratify the prosecution of the equity proceeding to final decree and further authorize the Solicitor to proceed with any subsequent supplemental proceedings that may be advisable, necessary or appropriate to effectuate all of the foregoing and secure compliance therewith.
