

Reallocation of Fourth Year Community Development Block Grant Activity

BE IT ENDED IN WISDOM, by the Board Of Supervisors of West Bradford Township, PA.

WHEREAS, An application has been made for fourth year community development block grant activity to rehabilitate 1052 Glenside Avenue, Downingtown, Pa.

WHEREAS, The Redevelopment Authority of Chester County has found that the property in question has deteriorated to the point it is infeasible to rehabilitate.

WHEREAS, The Redevelopment Authority of Chester County recommends that the property be acquired and demolished.

WHEREAS, The Board Of Supervisors must resolve to reallocate the rehabilitation funds to acquire the property and demolish the structure and appoint two appraisers at a set fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED by the Board Of Supervisors of West Bradford Township that the Fourth Year Community Development Block Grant for 1052 Glenside Avenue be reallocated to acquire and clear the property.
