

RESOLUTION 82-04

This Resolution made and adopted this 23rd day of February, 1982.

Whereas, Hamilton Bank, has offered to grant and convey unto West Bradford Township all that certain tract or parcel of land situate in West Bradford Township bounded and described according to a subdivision plan of Fox Trail Development, Phase I, made for J.W.H. Construction Co. by Berger and Hayes, Inc., Engineers and Surveyors, dated November 1, 1977 and last revised February 18, 1982.


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township that said roadway has been constructed in accordance with said plan and in accordance with the specifications of the West Bradford Township Subdivision Ordinance.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Supervisors that acceptance of said road as a public road would be in the best interest of West Bradford Township.


NOW THEREFORE, be it and it hereby is resolved that the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township accept the Deed of Dedication proposed by Hamilton Bank, said deed being dated February 23, 1982, at that time and hereafter the said parcel described in said deed, and known as Fox Trail Road and a portion of Steeple Chase Road and a portion of Sawmill Road shall hereafter be owned by West Bradford Township to be used as a public roadway.


