

**A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CHESTER COUNTY ACT 101
MUNICIPAL WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN ADOPTED BY THE
TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD**

Whereas, the Pennsylvania Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act of July 28, 1988 P.L. 556, No. 101, 53 P.S. (hereinafter referred to as Act 101) provides for the processing and disposal of municipal waste and requires Counties to submit waste management plans for waste generated within County boundaries for at least a ten year period; and

Whereas, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources (hereinafter referred to as the "Department"), by letter dated March 23, 1988, approved the 1987 Chester County Solid Waste Management Plan which was prepared under Act 97 on behalf of all Chester County Municipalities at their request and which was approved by 68 of the County's 73 municipalities; and

Whereas, the Department, by letter dated January 12, 1989, notified the County that the Plan had achieved the necessary requirements for final "grandfather" approval under Section 501(b) of Act 101; and

Whereas, the Department, by letter dated March 16, 1990, approved the Plan under Act 101; and

Whereas, the Chester County Board of Commissioners appointed a Municipal Waste Advisory Committee on May 30, 1989, to assist them with revisions to the Plan as required by Section 502 of act 101; and

Whereas, the Advisory Committee, with the assistance of County Staff and BCM Engineers, Inc. prepared the Draft Chester County Act 101 Waste Management Plan which was distributed to all municipal officials and other official repositories for public review and comment from May 8, 1990 to July 31, 1990; and

Whereas, the Advisory Committee also conducted two public hearings on May 29, 1990 and May 31, 1990 at which meetings the public tendered comments on the Plan to the Advisory Committee; and

Whereas, the Advisory Committee has considered all public comment received on the Plan and has revised the plan, where deemed appropriate, to respond to comment and forwarded the revised Plan and the Advisory Committee's response to all comments to the Chester County Board of Commissioners for their consideration; and

Whereas, the Chester County Board of Commissioners adopted the Chester County Act 101 Waste Management Plan on August 14, 1990 and directed that it be forwarded to all 73 municipalities for ratification within 90 days of adoption; and

Whereas, the appropriate municipal officials have reviewed the findings and recommendations of the Plan and have found the Plan to be acceptable; now

Therefore, be it resolved that the Township of West Bradford hereby ratifies the Chester County Act 101 Municipal Waste Management Plan dated August 1990, prepared by Chester County in accordance with the provisions of Act 101.
