

RESOLUTION 91-03

WHEREAS, West Bradford Township has received information that the Broad Run Sewer Company has filed a request to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to increase the rates for sewer service; and

WHEREAS, that request is to raise the rates from \$75.00 per quarter to \$112.00 per quarter; and

WHEREAS, that would amount to an increase of 49.27%; and

WHEREAS, a comparison has been made with other area sewer rates; and


WHEREAS, the average of a number of other area sewer facilities, contacted in random survey, is \$55.00 per quarter; and

WHEREAS, the Public Utility Commission is solely responsible to accept or reject the request from the Broad Run Sewer Company.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission be informed that the township does feel that the proposed rate is out of the ordinary and that a complete and thorough review be made of the information filed by the Broad Run Sewer Company.
