DEDICATION OF BENT OAK TRAIL AND TIMBERLAND DRIVE


WHEREAS, Bernard T. J. Vishneski has offered to grant and convey unto West Bradford Township all that certain tract or parcel of land situate in West Bradford Township bounded and described according to a subdivision plan of Deer Valley, made by Henry S. Conroy, Inc., Division of Chester Valley Engineers, Inc., date July 25, 1983 and last revised November 2, 1987.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township that said roadway has been constructed in accordance with said plan and in accordance with the specifications of the West Bradford Subdivision Ordinance.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Supervisors that acceptance of said road as a public road would be in the best interest of West Bradford Township.

NOW THEREFORE, be it and it hereby is resolved that the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township accept the Deed of Dedication proposed by Bernard T. J. Vishneski said deed being dated August 13, 1991 at that time and hereafter the said parcel described in said deed, and known as right of way of Bent Oak Trail and Timberland Drive and widened right-of-way of Hall Road, T-387 shall hereafter be owned by West Bradford Township to be used as public roadways.
