**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF THE KEYSTONE RECREATION,
PARK AND CONSERVATION FUND (SENATE BILL 393)**

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's parks, public libraries, recreation facilities and natural and historic sites are among our states greatest resources; and

WHEREAS, there currently is not a stable source of funding for these resources; and

WHEREAS, many of these facilities have been allowed to deteriorate; and

WHEREAS, an immediate, long term investment is necessary to rehabilitate and improve these facilities; and

WHEREAS, the planning, acquisition, development and rehabilitation of parks, public libraries, recreation facilities and historic sites is vital to local tourism, economic development and recreation; and


WHEREAS, the Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation Fund would provide a dedicated source of funding for recreation, parks, conservation, historic sites and public libraries;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the (Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township) urge the General Assembly and the Governor to enact the Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation Fund as soon as possible in order to address persistent problems and needs of Pennsylvania's state and local parks, recreation facilities, historic sites and public libraries.




