

**TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD  
RESOLUTION 93-13**

**A RESOLUTION PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS  
FOR USE OF THE MUNICIPAL CAMPUS  
PROPERTY.**

**WHEREAS**, West Bradford Township does own property that is known as "The Municipal Campus"; and

**WHEREAS**, that property serves to provide areas for different municipal functions and for use by the citizens of West Bradford; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to prescribe how that property should be used; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors has the right to regulate the use of that property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township that the following shall be considered as the rules and regulations for use of the municipal campus; including, but not limited to, the areas designated for recreation.


- \* No person shall be permitted on the municipal campus during hours of darkness except for those persons that are conducting official township business. Use of recreation area shall not be considered official township business unless there is an event being directed by township officials, their designees or contractors engaged to oversee said event.
- \* No person shall operate a bicycle, skateboard, scooter or motor vehicle upon any sidewalk, curb or other area designated as being prohibited for these type of vehicles. This prohibition shall not be intended to apply to any conveyance used by a handicapped person as may be necessary to provide mobility for them.
- \* No person, corporation, or other entity shall deposit or cause to be deposited on any portion of the municipal campus any material other than such items as have been designated to be deposited as part of a municipal program or as directed by a municipal employee having the authority to grant such permission.
- \* Signs, of any type, shall not be placed on the municipal campus without the express permission of the Board of Supervisors or the township manager.
- \* Any use of municipal facilities other than as provided by official direction, appropriate signage or by written permission granted through the office of the township manager is prohibited.

- \* Any person found to be violating any of the provisions of this resolution shall be deemed to be trespassing and may be prosecuted.
- \* This resolution is not intended to replace any other park use regulation established by the Board of Supervisors but be in addition to those already established. Where these regulations are in conflict with other park regulations of the municipality, the regulations contained herein shall be conclusively presumed to be dominant.




