*Whereas, he has undoubtedly prevented many crimes and helped to solve many crimes through his interest in and his activities in the community; and*


*Whereas, he has been a model police officer in the municipality;*

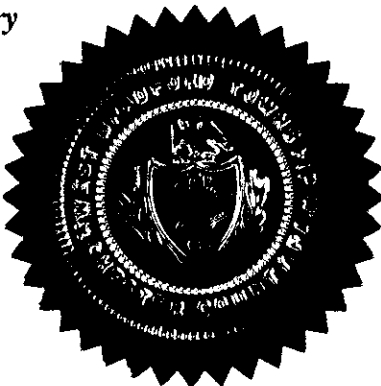
*Whereas, he is now retiring from the Pennsylvania State Police;*




