*WHEREAS, on or about January 7, 1996, a blizzard caused injury, damage, and or suffering to the persons and or property of West Bradford Township; and*



**DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, on or about January 7, 1996, a blizzard has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage and suffering to the persons and property of West Bradford Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the blizzard will or has endangered the health, safety, and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in West Bradford Township and threatens to create problems greater in scope than West Bradford Township may be able to resolve; and


**WHEREAS**, emergency measures are required to mitigate the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the affected residents;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 PA C.S.), as amended, a "Disaster Emergency" is declared for West Bradford Township, the effect of which is to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance thereunder.


This resolution shall take effect immediately and continue in force until January 14, 1996, unless continued or terminated.
