

RESOLUTION 96-13

TOWNSHIP OF WEST BRADFORD

DEDICATION OF HAMPTON DRIVE, OLD SHIRE LANE (now known as a part of Hampton Drive), PENNSFORD DRIVE, PENNSRIDGE PLACE, PENNSRIDGE COURT, PENNS LANE (now known as a part of Pennsridge Place), A PORTION OF SAW MILL ROAD AND VARIOUS DRAINAGE EASEMENTS.

WHEREAS Greene Townes Financial Corporation, successor to Devon Towne Corporation, has offered to grant and convey unto West Bradford Township all that certain tract or parcel of land situate in West Bradford Township bounded and described according to a final subdivision plan "The Colony at Brandywine Ridge" titled Record Plan - Penn's Woods and Hampshire Hills prepared by Conceptual Planners and Engineers, Inc., last revised April 4, 1989 and April 18, 1989, and;


WHEREAS it is the opinion of the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township that said roadways have been constructed in accordance with said plan and in accordance with the specifications of the West Bradford Subdivision Ordinance, and;

WHEREAS it is the opinion of the Board of Supervisors that acceptance of said roads as public roads would be in the best interest of West Bradford Township.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township accept the Deed of Dedication proposed by Greene Townes Financial Corporation successor to Devon Towne Corporation, said deed being dated December 10, 1996 at that time and hereafter the said parcels described in said deed, and known as right of way of Hampton Drive, Old Shire Lane (now known as a part of Hampton Drive), Pennsford Drive, Pennsridge Place, Pennsridge Court, Penns Lane (now known as a part of Pennsridge Place), a portion of Saw Mill Road and various drainage easements shall hereafter be owned by West Bradford Township to be used as public roadways.


