

**RESOLUTION 97-03**

**A RESOLUTION TO FILE THE ASSESSMENT FOR FIRE HYDRANT SERVICE WITH THE TOWNSHIP TREASURER FOR COLLECTION**

WHEREAS, there are fire hydrants in certain areas of West Bradford Township, and;

WHEREAS, those hydrants are served by the Philadelphia Suburban Water Company, a public utility, and;

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission has approved a tariff for said hydrants, and;

WHEREAS, the Philadelphia Suburban Water Company has notified the township that it will bill the township for fire hydrant service pursuant to the tariff approved by the P.U.C., and;


WHEREAS, the costs for fire hydrant service will be assessed to the properties that accrue a benefit from fire hydrant service, and;

WHEREAS, Section 3302 of the Second Class Township Code states that when an assessment for service is implemented by the Board of Supervisors and the collection of which is not charged to the tax collector, the assessments for the service shall be filed with the township treasurer.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED that any assessment for fire hydrant service be filed with the township treasurer for collection. The township treasurer shall give thirty days notice that the assessments are due and payable. If any assessment remains unpaid ninety days after the due date, it shall be turned over to the township solicitor for collection in the manner as specified by Section 3302 of the Second Class Township Code.
