**A RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION FOR AN
ACT 537 SEWAGE FACILITIES PLAN UPDATE**

*Sewage Facilities Plan Update - Special Study
Route 162 and Strasburg Road Corridor Study Area
West Bradford Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania*

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, Number 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as Amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, the Department adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requiring the Municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan for the provision of adequate sewage systems and to revise and plan from time to time as may necessary, and;

WHEREAS, the Municipality has prepared the said plan and has found it adequate for the wastewater disposal and management needs of the planning area, and;


WHEREAS, the Department has requested the municipality to revise Resolution 97-08 to include the phasing of implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township of West Bradford (the Municipality) hereby adopts the plan know as the Sewage Facilities Plan Update-Special Study - Route 162 and Strasburg Road Corridor Study Area. The Municipality hereby assures that Department of the Proper and timely implementation of the said plan as set forth therein including the phasing related to approval need from Newlin Township.

The plan provides for the installation of a sewage collection system and the phased construction of a lagoon/spray irrigation system, with a design capacity of 135,000 gallons per day (GPD), to serve the long-term sewage disposal needs of the Village of Marshallton and surrounding areas and the Tattersall Golf Community.


