
Whereas, the Board of Supervisors have adopted Ordinance 99-04; wherein it is prescribed that an annual fee shall be set by resolution for fire hydrant protection for properties benefiting from fire hydrants;

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors have determined that the fee for 2000 shall be twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per tax parcel served;

Now, therefore be it, and it hereby is resolved, by the Board of Supervisors that the annual fee for 2000 for fire hydrant protection shall be twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per tax parcel served.


