*A Resolution Honoring Corporal John J. Malone
For His Heroic Services and Protection of the Citizens
of West Bradford Township*

Whereas, Corporal John J. Malone has been a member of the Pennsylvania State Police since 1993; and

Whereas, he served in Troop J at the Embreeville Barrack; and,

Whereas, Corporal Malone responded to an armed robbery at Spauldings' Citgo Service Station and the Marshallton Village Store on Sunday, January 16, 2000; and

Whereas, he pursued the suspect in a vehicle to Lieder's Road at Broad Run Road; and

Whereas, he then pursued the armed suspect, on foot and attempted to knock the gun away from the suspect; and


Whereas, he fired upon the suspect in order to protect the residents of West Bradford Township and Trooper Jerry P. Cessna; and

Whereas, it has been determined that Corporal Malone used proper police procedures and tactics in this situation, which served to further, protect and benefit the citizens of West Bradford Township.

Now, therefore, be it and it is hereby resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Bradford that Corporal John J. Malone is recognized for his heroic service and protection of the residents of West Bradford Township. .
