Whereas, he serves in Troop J at the Embreeville Barrack; and,

Whereas, Trooper Cessna responded to an armed robbery at Spauldings' Citgo Service Station and the Marshallton Village Store on Sunday, January 16, 2000; and

Whereas, he pursued the suspect in a vehicle to Lieds Road at Broad Run Road; and

Whereas, he then pursued the armed suspect, on foot and attempted to apprehend the suspect; and


Whereas, he fired upon the suspect in order to protect the residents of West Bradford Township and Corporal John T. Malone; and




