**A RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN A
COOPERATIVE PURCHASE CONTRACT WITH THE
CITY OF HARRISBURG**

Whereas, Section 1902 of Act 57 of May 15, 1998, (Title 62 Pa C.S. 1902), known as the "Commonwealth Procurement Code," permitting local public procurement units, local municipalities, and authorities to sponsor, establish, participate in, conduct, or administer a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of any goods, materials, equipment, or services with another local public procurement unit. A "local procurement unit" is defined as, among other entities, any political subdivision; and


Whereas, West Bradford Township is a political subdivision; and

Whereas, it is hereby deemed to be in the best interest of West Bradford Township to participate in the 2002 Pennsylvania Capital City Vehicle and Equipment Contract, which is administered by the City of Harrisburg;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of West Bradford Township, that West Bradford Township will participate in the 2002 Pennsylvania Capital City Vehicle and Equipment Contract by purchasing supplies and services from the contract, and based upon the terms and conditions of the contract and at the same prices. Further, West Bradford Township will be responsible for direct payment to the contractor for any items that are purchased.
